Attendance and Punctuality

The return to school has been a busy time for office staff as we process the data from the Autumn Term. This has shown that our school is sitting below the national average for attendance. Whilst we appreciate there are winter bugs and people have had time off for operations, there are too many instances, where pupils fall into the persistently absent bracket (below 90%). At Dordon, we work closely with our ACE officer to track attendance and address issues of absence. We hope that the Autumn term is simply a reflection of winter germs and it will improve over the next two terms.

Good attendance at school is vital for pupils to achieve their full educational potential. Pupils with good attendance records benefit in the following ways:-

- Continuity of learning which makes progress and retention
 easier
- . Enhanced performance in lessons and examinations
- Continuity of relationships and friendships with adults and peers
- · Good habits that are formed for later life

Children by law must attend school and all schools are required to record details of pupils' attendance and absence at school. We do so at the beginning of each morning and afternoon sessions and within strict time limits. We are also required to report poor attendance.

It is also equally important that children arrive in school on time. When pupils miss the start of the day, they often miss important information which may cause them disruption for the remainder of that day. If a child misses 10 minutes a day, that is 50 minutes per week. That would equate to 32 hours a year, a whole teaching week missed. At Dordon, we often use the start of the day for important interventions or to review the work from the previous day. Please ensure your child is in school on time every day to maximise their learning potential.

Each week we acknowledge the class with the best attendance in celebration assembly and post regular updates on the weekly newsletter. Keep an eye on the figures over the coming weeks to check we, as a school, are improving and make sure we each play our part in achieving better statistics.

Spot Light on Excellence...


Presentation
