Swift visit to the Butterfly Farm and MAD Museum in Stratford-upon-Avon

Our visit will:

- Take place on Thursday 4th April 2019
- Depart at 9:00am and return at approximately 2.45pm
- Led by Mr Guard-Ward
- Cost £16.35

We have identified an exciting opportunity to visit one location that will support our learning in both the spring and summer terms. We appreciate the cost is a little higher than normal but this is because we are combining both our spring and summer trips into one single informative and interactive visit.

The Butterfly Farm in Startford-upon-Avon will support our learning this term on animals and their habitats. Our visit to the farm will include the opportunity to stroll through the wonderful world of a unique and exotic, rainforest environment with splashing waterfalls and fish-filled pools. This will allow us the chance to view some of the world's most spectacular and colourful butterflies. In addition to this, we will visit the Discovery zone to observe the amazing life-cycle of a butterfly. We'll have the opportunity to see one of the largest insect collections in the UK and watch the fascinating Leafcutter ants.

As part of our trip we will also visit the MAD Museum, the UK's only Mechanical Art Venue. The MAD Museum encourages learners to interact, examine and be inspired by the one-off inventions on display. If you're not quite sure what mechanical art is all about, think of the machines and gizmos used in Wallace and Gromit and Chitty Chitty Bang Bang. In a nutshell, mechanical art is usually beautifully crafted, moving sculptures either made to have an exaggerated purpose or made simply for the fun of it. This will support our work on Inventors and their inventions as well as D&T work.

Children will need a healthy packed lunch and a bottle of water. Children who have free school meals will be provided with a packed lunch by the school kitchen (please let the office know if you do not require a packed lunch). Please ensure children do not bring sweets and/or fizzy drinks or any other items that would be prohibited on a normal school day.
