Our New Pupils

'making sure our new pupils get the best possible start'

Strange as it might seem, at this time of year we are not only thinking of finishing the academic year, but are also involved in full scale preparations for next academic year!

Throughout our primary schools, all manner of 'induction activities' are currently taking place. For our new Reception children, we have already visited many of the 'settings' children will come from and also hosted 'open mornings' and 'parents induction meetings' to explain how our schools work. Children are also welcome into school to visit the class and attend sessions such as 'story time' sessions. These events are designed to ensure that parents and children not only feel part of the 'big family' but also understand how our school works.

In September we will also conduct 'home visits' which again builds that important link between home and school. During 'home visits' our new children get the chance to see their teacher in a familiar setting and also for parents to share any concerns or worries.

We also make sure that our Year 6 children are extremely well prepared for their next big step. Apart from regular visits to secondary schools throughout the year, and meetings between teachers to talk about the children, we are also very grateful to colleagues from secondary schools who visit us to get to know them and answer any questions they might have. Our children also benefit from all manner of 'familiarisation sessions' at their new schools, which are arranged by academic departments. A number of sessions are arranged for the remainder of this term.

'Induction' is however not limited to the start and end of each year. Because of the very large number of children that have joined us mid-year, we have excellent arrangements in place to ensure that new pupils feel comfortable starting their new school. A 'mid-year' starter is always given a 'School Shadow'; a role the children are proud to undertake. A 'Shadow' meets their new friend at the start of the school day, helps them find their coat peg, shows them about, play with them at lunchtime and generally looks after them in their first few weeks.

Parental surveys results consistently show 'outstanding practise' in this area and make us feel very proud. Parents tell us that children who join us feel safe, secure and settled and make excellent progress with us. We care a great deal about ALL of our children and will do our utmost to ensure they are well prepared, happy and confident.

ICT supporting learning

Over half term, we have worked hard to ensure our new ICT equipment is in school and ready to use.

We have invested funds in more laptops and ipads for teachers to use in the delivery of lessons. Years 1-3 have new interactive whiteboards which are bigger and clearer for use in lessons.

We have purchased software for stop motion animation and green screen work to enhance our curriculum and a set of bluebots which are floor robots that can be programmed via Bluetooth connections from the ipad. This will help with the programming element of the new computing curriculum.

I am looking forward to seeing all of the new purchases in action this half term and next year.
