## **Emotional Health and Wellbeing**

There is much in the news currently about increasing concerns around mental health in children and young adults. As a school we believe that we have a significant role to play in supporting pupils in this area. Indeed as the issue increases, external services are becoming increasingly stretched. Therefore we are having to develop our skills in house to provide early intervention and hopefully minimise the chances of reaching crisis point.

In school, we have developed our 5 a day of emotional wellbeing:

- 1) Connect with other people
- 2) Learn something new
- 3) Be aware of your own feelings
- 4) Get active
- 5) Do something good for others

We are lucky to have staff who genuinely care about each and every one of the children in our school. They notice even the smallest changes and will open the door to a conversation. Talking about how you feel is essential as a mechanism to cope. I often use the analogy of a glass of water. When you first pick it up, it is light but the longer you hold on to it the heavier and more troublesome it becomes. The same is true of worries and concerns. If you can tell someone and put the glass down it will take some of the strain away.

Over the coming months, we will be sharing information with you about the Thrive approach which will allow us to develop emotional health and wellbeing further in our school. I am excited about this as an initiative.


