Senior Leadership Team

Across our two schools, Dordon and Wood End, we have a team of senior staff who work tirelessly to secure the best outcomes for the children in our care. Each member of the team has responsibility for different aspects of the schools but work collaboratively so everyone has a clear understanding of the position of each school and the direction to move forward. The Senior Leadership Team (SLT) consists of:

Mrs Cross - Executive Headteacher. Mrs Cross has strategic responsibility for both schools. She is the person who is in charge overall and is held to account over the performance of the school. Her time is split between Dordon and Wood End, depending on priorities within each school at any given time.

Miss McGroarty - Associate Head Dordon. Miss McGroarty has the day to day responsibility for the running of Dordon as she is in school every day. She has responsibility for the Newly Qualified Teacher programme, the work of trainee teachers and the standards in school.

Mrs Smith - Associate Head Wood End. Mrs Smith has the day to day responsibility for running Wood End, She also manages PE across both schools and Humanities at Wood End. She also manages standards in the school.

Miss Lewis - SENDCO both schools. Miss Lewis is responsible for SEND provision in school, liaising with external agencies and line managing teaching assistants. She is also the lead for Early Help.

Mrs Garrett - **English Lead**. Mrs Garrett is based at Wood End and teaches in Reception. She is responsible for standards in English (reading, writing and VGPS) across both schools.

Mrs Hopkins - Maths Lead. Mrs Hopkins is based at Dordon and teaches in Year 2. She is responsible for standards in maths across both schools.

The SLT are a crucial part of school improvement and we have a very effective team who are all committed to securing the best possible outcomes for our children.

Emotional Intelligence at Dordon

This term at Dordon we are going to be promoting emotional intelligence in class and around school. What does this mean I hear you ask? Emotional intelligence is the capacity to be aware of, control, and express one's emotions, and to handle relationships carefully and empathetically. As a staff we have carefully considered the following points:

- Self-awareness how do I feel about that?
- Self-regulation how will I manage those feelings?
- Motivation using feelings to achieve goals
- Empathy tuning in to how others feel
- Social skills handling feelings well in interactions with others

Schools are brilliant places to learn and promote these skills. With this in mind we have introduced our <u>'5 a Day'</u> poster in each class:


- 1. Connect with other people
