Spot Light on Excellence... Attendance and Lateness

Well done to all the pupils who are still on track for 100% attendance this year. There are 28 pupils in school who haven't missed a session since September.

We are very lucky here that so many parents are supportive of school and regularly send their children to school. It is vital that pupils come to school every day so that they do not get gaps in their learning.

Under new guidance, if a child's attendance drops below 90% they are classed as persistently absent. We track and monitor any pupils who meet this criterion or who are in danger of dropping below that figure.

Thank you for getting your children to school on time. There has been a reduction in the number of lates this term. It is essential that pupils are in school and ready to start learning on time as it sets them up for the whole day.
