Stranger Danger

I frequently get emails in school notifying me that children have been approached on their way to or from a school in Warwickshire and asking me to reinforce our 'Stranger Danger' message. We do not talk about Stranger Danger in our school.

At our school, we continuously talk about how to stay safe but more importantly what to do if you find yourself in a situation where you feel unsafe. At times like this we reinforce the idea of safe strangers. There may come a time when a stranger will be the only person who can help us. If we only teach 'stranger danger' then our children are not equipped well enough to deal with some situations.

Please reinforce school's message about safe strangers. For example, if you get lost in a shop who should you turn to for help? We advise children to look for people with store uniforms on, security guards or someone wearing a store ID badge. If you are at the park and feel unsafe, choose someone who doesn't give you your Early Warning Signs - a parent with other children for example.

Our children are becoming experts about identifying their Early Warning Signs - the physical reaction to feeling unsafe. They also know they should talk to or seek help from their network. However our network is not always immediately available which is why we need to talk about and identify safe strangers.

Thank you for your continued support with this. It has been recognised that our children understand about feeling safe and identify that school will help keep them safe.


