

Handwashing	<ul> <li>wash hands in their designated place</li> <li>use soap provided</li> <li>wash for 20 seconds</li> <li>wash hands every time they use toilet or sneeze</li> <li>wash hands at timetabled times throughout the day</li> <li>hand sanitiser stations throughout school</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>supervise handwashing and ensure hygiene guidance is being followed</li> <li>model handwashing by doing this when children do</li> <li>wash hands after touching children's work</li> <li>hand sanitiser stations throughout school</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>sinks to be cleaned regularly (at least 3 times daily)</li> <li>check soap is topped up</li> <li>water is appropriate temperature</li> <li>Display key messages around school</li> <li>corridors are marked out for movement around school to maximise social distance</li> </ul>
Learning time	<ul> <li>use only the resources that are provided for them</li> <li>stay in their designated areas</li> <li>maintain 2m where possible if moving outside for learning</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>deliver planned lessons by year group teacher</li> <li>avoid going over to children's desks</li> <li>wash hands before and after touching children's work</li> <li>focus on verbal feedback in the lesson.</li> <li>No expectation for written marking</li> <li>follow guidance from government about tasks that should be avoided</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>resources to be cleaned before and after use (EYFS) every day</li> <li>social groups will not share resources in EYFS</li> <li>learning to be planned to be outside where possible</li> </ul>

Break time	<ul> <li>stay in their designated playground zone at all times</li> <li>play socially distant games</li> <li>avoid touching their faces</li> <li>remain socially distant to come back into school</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>supervise children on the playground in their playground zones in year groups on a rota</li> <li>first aid to be administered as per guidance</li> <li>remind children about boundaries</li> <li>be vigilant around social distancing</li> </ul>	- playground to be zoned into 3 clear areas with 2m buffer zone between them
Lunch time	<ul> <li>children to have their own space to eat in every day</li> <li>when possible children to sit outside 2m apart</li> <li>Stay as a family group, move as a family group and play in their designated zone</li> <li>remain socially distant to come back into school</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>clean classroom tables and chairs before taking lunch</li> <li>only use the staffroom at the designated time</li> <li>MDS to be allocated to a specific zone in which to work to minimise contact with children</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>clean tables thoroughly between sittings with cleaning products (not just wiped)</li> <li>ALL toilets to be cleaned over the lunch period</li> <li>playground to be zoned into 3 clear areas with 2m buffer zone between them</li> </ul>
