## Parking

Parking on the school run is an issue many schools face. Our school is no different. There have been numerous complaints from local residents about parking near our school. As road users it is your responsibility to follow the Highway Code and park responsibly and legally. Dangerous parking leads to endangering the safety of our pupils - your children. It is paramount that cars leave the yellow zig zag lines clear outside school. They are there to keep the area outside school safe. There have also been reports of parents becoming aggressive when challenged about their irresponsible parking. Parents are simply trying to keep their children safe from harm.

Local police are aware of the issue and have been patrolling the area issuing tickets to cars that are parked illegally. They may well repeat their visits over the coming weeks.

Please use the car park by Dordon surgery and walk to school to minimise the number of cars parked in the immediate vicinity to school.

A parent has recently complained to the council about the lack of crossing points for our pupils. The council responded saying that they had consulted with Dordon about traffic measures in the local area. This took place 3 to 4 years ago when Dordon was a considerably smaller school. Please be assured that school will be reviewing the traffic calming measures in our local area to improve the safety for our pupils.

Please play your part in keeping our children safe by parking responsibly and being mindful of children when driving near to school.
